ANNUAL GIVING STATEMENTS

Here are instructions to access your 2025 Giving Statement on CCB:

1. Log onto your CCB account at <https://emmanuelbc.ccbchurch.com/goto/giving>.
2. Select **Giving Statement**. The Giving Statements window will appear.
 - a. For Type, select **Individual** or **Family**.
 - b. For Date Range, select **Quick Date Range**, then select **Last Year**.
 - c. Check the **Show pledges on giving statement** box.
3. Click **Run Report**.

Note: These steps are optimized for a computer and may differ slightly on a mobile device.

Week of	Prayer Theme
March 1 - 7	God Is Holy (Psalm 99:1-9) "We need to set God aside from everything else in our lives. He deserves our worship. Unlike fine china, God is not fragile. He expects us to involve Him in all aspects of our daily lives and not just on special occasions. He wants to have a seat at the table with us for every meal."
March 8 - 14	God Is Love (1John 4:7-19) "Lord, we can truly know love by knowing You. Thank You, Lord, for your amazing love. Help us to reflect and share your love with others."
March 14 - 21	God Is Just (Psalm 7:1-13) "God is the righteous judge; He alone establishes justice. He sees all that we do, right and wrong. He probes deeply to understand our motives. The Lord vindicates the righteous and punishes the wicked."
March 22 - 28	God Is Omnipotent (Isaiah 44:6-9, 21-28) "Although God is all-powerful, we must make the decision to submit to His will in all areas our lives. When we give him access to all areas our lives, there is nothing that God will not do for us."
March 29 - April 4	God is Faithful (Deuteronomy 7:6-16) "Father, we honor you for your faithfulness. You have never broken a promise. You have never violated a covenant. You have never left a commitment unfilled. Lord, help us to continue to grow in our faithfulness to you and to rely on your promises to us."
