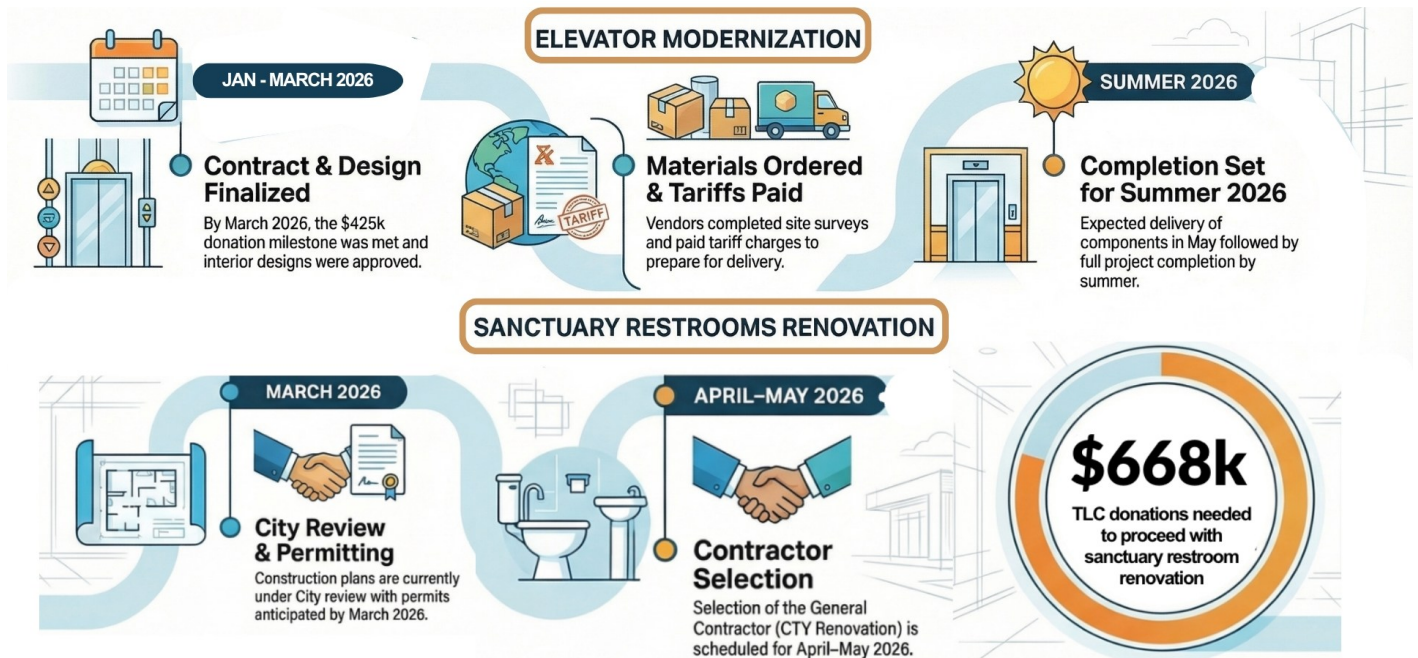

TLC CAMPAIGN PROJECT ROADMAP

Dec 2025- MAY 2026



We are grateful to share an update on our TLC building improvement projects. Since December 2025, we have made significant progress on both the Elevator Modernization and Sanctuary Restroom projects:

- ◇ We anticipate the Elevator Modernization will be completed by Summer 2026.
- ◇ Following that, we look forward to beginning renovations on the Sanctuary restrooms once city permits are secured and our donation milestone has been reached.

Stay tuned during the 1st Sunday of each month's worship service for monthly TLC donation updates. Thank you for your continued support, encouragement, and prayers as we move forward with these important improvements.

Note: Timelines are subject to change based on lead times for elevator components and municipal permitting schedules. The two projects are managed as *independent tracks* with separate contractors, permits, and funding triggers.

Week of	Prayer Theme
July 05 - July 11	Speaking Truth (Luke 18:18-30) "We are charged with spreading the Good News and letting the Holy Spirit do the saving. In what ways do you share the Good News with non-believers and invite them into a relationship with Jesus Christ? Remember, when we invite others to follow Christ? Remember, not everyone will say yes to the call"
July 12 - July 18	Extending Grace (Luke 19:1-10) "As Believers, we must become an channel to transmit God's grace to others. Remember, Jesus was willing to dine at Zacchaeus' home. Zacchaeus was marginized, and a despised outsider, but God's grace extends beyond normal social boundaries".
July 19 - July 24	Fellowship with Believers (1 Corinthians 1:1-13) "For the Believer, a life in Christ is a life of fellowship with other believers. Paul warned the Church at Corinth that there should be no divisions among God's people. Likewise, there should be no rivalry among God's people. Christ is not divided and either should God's people. As God's people, we must be one in Christ
July 25 - August 1	Wisdom From God (1Corinthians 1:1-13) "Believers have the wisdom of God because we have the Spirit of God within each one of us. God's spirit inside of us reveals the mind of God and how we should live our lives for Him. As the creator of the universe, God has absolute control over everything that happens in His creation, including the lives of his people."
