Week of	Prayer Theme
August 2	"The Importance of Character" (2 Peter 1:1-11) "The Lord has equipped us all with a Christlike Character. God has transformed us into His Likeness. As Christians, we must be diligent in our responsibility to live with the kind of character that points others to Jesus Christ to become both their Lord and Saviour".
August 3-9	"Godliness" (Timothy 4:6-16) "When we live Godly lives, it points others to Christ. It is not only important to study, learn and understand God's Word, but we must also actively apply God Word to our daily lives".
August 10-16	"Humility" (Philippians 2:1-11) "As Christ followers, our lives should mirror His Life. We must show the same love and concern that Christ showed in His dying for our sins. Humility calls for Christ Believers to consider the needs of others, before looking at our own needs".
August 17-23	"Contentment" (Philippians 4:10-20) "God has given us Everything we need; it is now up to us to be content with it. We must also be content in both the power and the provisions given to us by God".
August 24-30	"Genosity" (2 Corinthians 8:1-9) "Our Giving is not just our Money, it is also our time, love, support, and sometimes just listening to people. God generous Grace in us will move us to be generous to others".
August 31 September 6	"Integrity" (1 Peter 3:8-17) "God demands that we be the same Christ-centered, integrity based & focused person(s) at all times. Integrity is having strong moral principles, being honest & truthful, trustworthy & doing the right things all the time. Integrity is being constantly focused on Christ in our daily walk. Integrity, you have have it one day and lose it the next".
